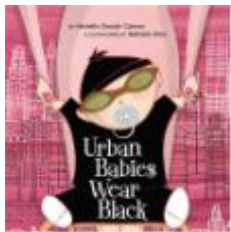




Panorama of the top level of the new building.

## MESSAGE OF THE MONTH

Urban babies love galleries, architecture and, of course, drinking lattes. These familiar descriptions are taken from the light-hearted kids book *Urban Babies Wear Black* by Michelle Sinclair Colman.



Perhaps the descriptions in *Eco Babies Wear Green* or *Foodie Babies Wear Bibs* are equally familiar to the Inner West. Regardless of whether these particular images

match your experiences of children around Broadway there is no doubt that the Inner West Baby Boom continues apace.

Recent privately funded research shows that the birth rate in Camperdown and the Inner West is still growing with the population growth rate of zero to two year olds expected to more than double **Sydney's overall population growth rate.** Dr Andrew Child, Director of Obstetrics at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital notes that the hospital has seen a 40% increase in the number of babies born over the past eight years.

Unsurprisingly then, many pre-schools and primary schools are full to capacity. It seems that children, and in coming years, teenagers will play an increasingly significant role in reshaping the face of Broadway and the inner suburbs.

Even, perhaps especially, here at Barneys the Baby Boom is wonderfully evident in both of our congregations. There have been 10 children born in the Barneys family the past year and presently, there are more than 5 pregnant couples (keep us posted, people!).

In light of the quickly changing demographics of the Inner West, Barneys has an opportunity as we return to Broadway to consider how we can engage with, care for and serve the children and families in our community. Let me offer three modest proposals:

### Pray for our parents and kids

The most obvious connection we have to families and kids is our families and kids. Please pray for our parents and kids that they will have many opportunities through mothers groups, play groups, pre-school and child care, school, sports clubs, social clubs and other networks. Christians are called to be salt and light. Pray that our families can be salty and light-y in the midst of the wonderful chaos of life with children.

### Give thanks for and continue to resource and support our kids leaders

Praise God for the people who presently lead our little (and little-ish) people. As we seek to reach more and more people with the gospel we will need more and more leaders to love and serve the children and teenagers in our church. We will need people, young and old, who love Jesus and love kids and youth.

Pray that God, in his abundant generosity, will provide these crucial people.

### Explore new opportunities to bless families

There will be simple blessings in moving back to Broadway. Partly such the use of an actual crying and change room and a **main worship space that doesn't require strollers to be lifted up several flights of stairs!**

But in addition to this, having a multi-function spaces available to us through the week opens up many new possibilities.

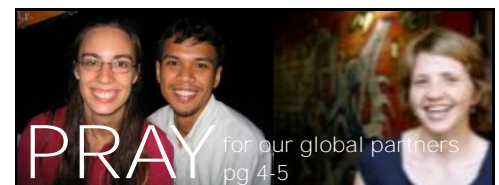
Before the old building burnt down a team of parents were on the brink of starting a Barneys play-group. After more than 5 years we can finally begin planning again! Others in our congregation are researching homework clubs as well as reading and literacy classes as opportunities to serve and reach our community. One of the best parts of my role is to teach Primary Scripture classes. The kids love Scripture and these classes and connections have confirmed in my mind the value of after school kids clubs.

In addition to all of this the visibility and the flexibility of the new Barneys Building enables us to consider a greater range of Youth activities and ministries (recessed lighting!).

The significance of the new building is further highlighted by the lack of community spaces for families in Broadway and the city. In an area struggling to adjust to the growing numbers of families, Barneys provides a safe and welcoming space for children and young people.

The new building is not the cure-all, but it does provide the space for our community to exercise imaginative and creative ways to love the people of Broadway and the Inner West. There are more and more families with children moving to the city, my prayer is that as they discover the joy of piccolo lattes and the arts they will also discover Jesus; his love for the city, his love for families, his love for urban babies.

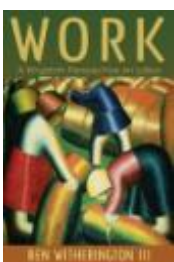

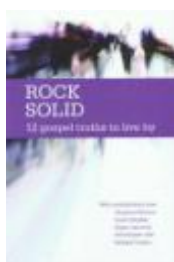

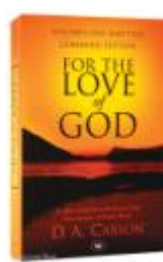

## BARNEYS PHILIPPINES PARTNERSHIP AND TEAM TRIP 2011

Four years ago as a church community Barneys committed to supporting 3 churches in Metro Manila who minister amongst the poor. This support has been financial as well as a partnership in prayer and building relationships with our brothers and sisters at Calvary Christian Church, Batasan Hills Bible Church and Tay Tay Bridge Church.

Our support has been given through Care Channels international who work with local churches to implement programs including education sponsorship and livelihood businesses to create sustainable long-term change for communities. Medical, dental, and feeding programs are also important in meeting the immediate needs of those who would otherwise have no substantial daily meals and no healthcare.

**This year Barneys sent it's second team to the Philippines to continue building our relationship with our partner churches.** We took part in 4 medical missions at each of our partners churches, assisted with a Daily Vacation Bible School (DVBS) for school aged children and to took part in regular Sunday services. Our team of three doctors, one teacher, a minister and a team organiser were all able to use their skills and gifts to contribute to the ministry activities we took part in.

**Calvary Christian Fellowship and School** are led by Pastors Nelson and Elaine Praxidio, who once again welcomed us into their home, shared meals, prayed with us and invited us to join in with some activities of their church during our team visit. This included Caro preaching in their Sunday church service, giving our testimonies in church and taking part in some singing and story telling for their DVBS. Our team was part of two Medical Missions with Calvary Fellowship, one in Manila and one at their sister church in Laguna.

Calvary Christian Church has recently started a church fellowship in Caluan, Laguna. A large number of **Calvary's congregation members were relocated to this government resettlement area 3 hours south of Manila** after the 2009 floods. This church plant is being lead by Pastor Mark, a young leader from **Calvary's leadership team. The church is growing in numbers and Nelson and Mark are initiating programs** including construction of a fish farm to create employment opportunities in the community.

The resettlement area in Caluan is quite isolated and without job opportunities. As a result many men and some women are forced to live apart from the their families in Manila to work to provide for them. By creating industry to employ people in the local area it is hoped that families may once again be able to live together.

**Tay Tay Bridge Church** is another of our partner churches who we had the opportunity to visit and to take part in their annual medical mission. The church leadership have strong community links and run many programs to give opportunities to those in great need. While visiting with them we learnt of their targeted feeding program that seeks to use weight data collected from a community medical centre of the most undernourished local children and provide them with 2 meals a day for 5 days a week until their weight is brought back up to a normal range.

**Our doctors discussed several ideas with Care Channels Manila's doctors about how we could assist them with improvements in the implementation of their healthcare.** One of these was the idea of employing a full-time community nurse to be available regularly for consultation and education on health matters. Another important issue identified was the need to keep electronic records of the patients at each consultation. Currently only one medical mission is run per church each year and the gap in information that occurs without health records makes the work of the doctors and dentists difficult. Both of these strategies require resources that are currently beyond the reach of the medical programs, however it is hoped that we may be able to work alongside Care Channels to implement them.

**Batasan Hills Bible Church** in Quezon City is lead by Pastor Randy Ramos who also works fulltime for Care Channels as the Philippines Coordinator of their Child Education Sponsorship Program. We met many of the scholars who are currently or have in the past been part of this program that provides approximately AUS\$100/ year/ child to pay for the school supplies they require throughout their academic year. Many of them have been able to go on to further college education and are also youth leaders, leading and teaching in their DVBS.

While visiting with Batasan Hills to assist with their medical mission, we were invited by Dr Malyn to take part and teach in their Community Health Education Program (CHE) which is a trial program **being run by Care Channels in conjunction with Pastor Randy's leadership. Fifteen community members** have committed to attending lessons in disease awareness and prevention and in Christian bible teaching, and then undertaking a program of visiting the homes of local families to share this **knowledge. It's hoped that this pilot program may grow and become tremendously effective in educating the local communities about health issues and Christian faith and that it will be adopted widely among Care Channels partner churches.**



### Prayer for our Partners...

As our partnership with these churches through Care Channels grows please pray that as they seek to serve those in need that they are continually strengthened in their love and faithfulness in the Lord and that their physical and spiritual needs are met. We can all give thanks for our opportunity to partner with Calvary, Batasan, and TayTay Churches and **pray that we continue to respond to God's prompting to generosity and creativity in how we assist them and show our love for them in Christ.**

- Thanks to CMS who funded Ruth's travel by plane (due to the floods) to be able to physically attend KCC Youth program.
- Please pray for the newly formed church of St Marks Bickerton - thanks for the church leaders, Veronica and Alistair, and that it will grow spiritually and numerically.
- Thanks for the opportunities for Ruth to do voluntary teaching at Numbulwar school in the senior class, Yrs 9-12, where she can go for a few hours each morning. Pray that this will help her grow relationships with the girls and that she can invite them to bible study.
- Pray for safety during this time of Gunabibi ceremony (a men's ceremony that lasts an undefined time and restricts women from doing activities in certain areas or travelling in cars or planes). ## Summary of June 2011 meeting

The monthly Parish Council meeting was held on 13 June 2011.

- **Mike Paget gave an update on the church's** ministry, including giving thanks for many recent baptisms.
- The wardens reported that the new building is progressing well. The wardens led a discussion regarding the possible uses for the new church building and its income producing potential. The wardens noted that some of the unexercised options for the building will need to be costed and a decision made by Parish Council as to whether to exercise those options.
- Peter Stone presented a fundraising report, noting that the outcome of several grant applications to government and community donors is not yet known. He asked for prayer for the Seven Churches Walk 2011, which will be held on 17 September 2011.

- The church treasurer Grant Parish tabled the May church accounts, noting with great thanks to God that offertories were slightly ahead of budget in May (\$63,254 received / \$62,500 budget). Offertories remain approximately \$10,000 behind budget for the year.
- An extended Parish Council meeting was scheduled for 30 July 2011 to discuss the building project and the 2012 church operational budget.

Please join us in giving thanks for the offertories in May. Please pray for the upcoming Parish Council meeting, that we would have wisdom and discernment. Please also pray for the Seven Churches Walk and the continued safety of builders constructing the new building.

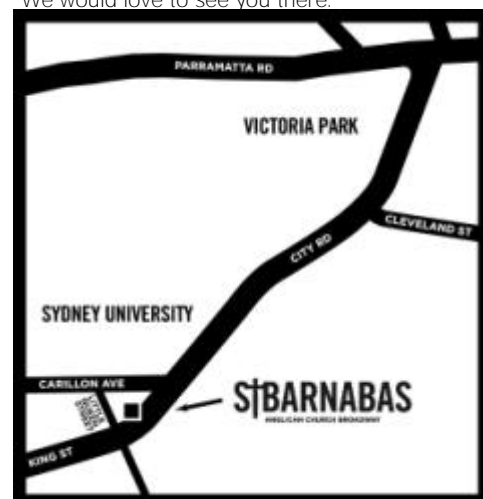

**My name is** Jodi McLaren

**I am** going back to studying this year, having worked in student ministry for the last 7 years. **So I'm back at Sydney Missionary and Bible College** doing my Masters of Arts in Theology

**My favourite bible verse is** 2 Timothy 4:1-5 because it reminds me that when the rest of the world would have us try and compromise the truth of the Gospel, we need to be faithful to Him and just keep being the people that He has called us to be in order to bring Him glory.

**At Barneys, I'm most enjoying** getting to know people (although that's also the most challenging!) **I've only been coming since December so it's a bit intimidating sometimes, but I've been really thankful for** how welcoming and friendly people have been.

**One thing God is currently teaching me is** in thinking through what it means to be adopted into His family. He takes us as we are, without conditions, boundaries or barriers. He has shown us love that, in a way, makes Him vulnerable to us rejecting Him and yet because of great mercy and kindness **He does it anyway. I'm finding it a bit confronting and something to keep working through when at times when I'm tempted to be a little more 'self protective' or a bit more conditional in my love for others and I'm thankful that we never get this in** Jesus.

**A book (mmm, actually I'm going to say two!) that has influenced my life with God is "Life Together" by Dietrich Bonhoeffer and "Cross Centred Life" by CJ Mahaney** – I try and read both once a year (they're only little and you can read them in a weekend if you want) because both are a brilliant reminder about what it means to cling to the Cross alone (Mahaney) and then what that looks like to live out in the community of God's people (Bonhoeffer).

**I really like cooking (I'm pretty sure I think about food about 6 hours a day!), photography, getting some exercise and hanging out with the people I love while drinking good coffee.**

**I'm most happy eating** brunch – it's the best meal ever! When else can you legitimately combine eggs, sourdough, avocado, salmon, coffee, champagne, chocolate and strawberries all in one meal??? Let alone corn fritters, semi dried tomatoes.... What was I saying about loving food?

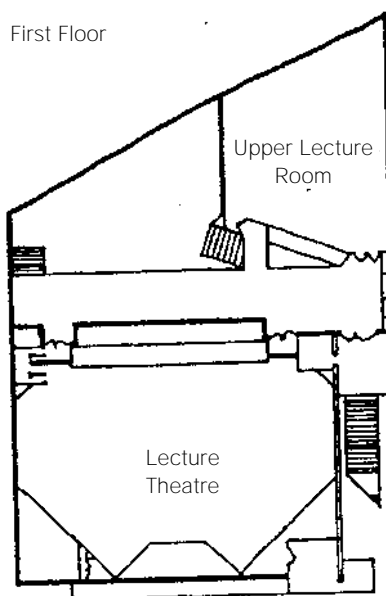
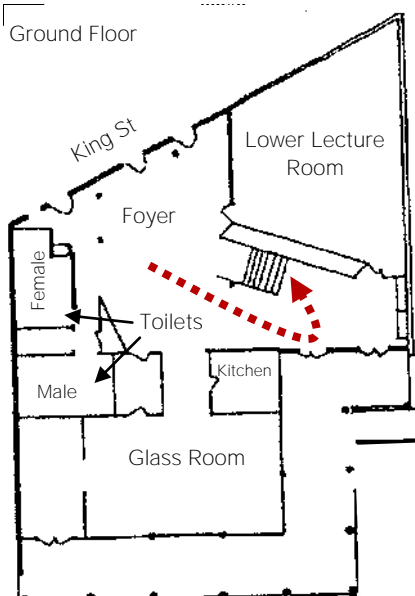
