



MESSAGE OF THE MONTH

By the time this article goes to print and you are reading it, there will only be a couple of weeks till the New Year. Do you 'do' New Year's resolutions? What will they be? - less time in the office? More exercise? Start a hobby?

Have you ever wondered how the whole idea relates to the life of the Christian?

The inner city is full of people with a passion for self-improvement. When I (rarely) drop by the gym at Sydney Uni, whole classes of the lycra clad are thrashing away under the guidance of a step-class instructor (I don't have any particular objection to lycra, by the way - after all, I am a cyclist). Street by street, tired terraces and warehouses are being gutted and refreshed, a metaphor for the internal projects of their owners. Though the self-help fad appears to have waned, it's really just that the focus has shifted. The top ten non-fiction bestsellers at HarperCollins include six books on cooking.

The Christian gospel speaks powerfully into this drive. It tells us that there is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus. That we have already been given, and do not need to win, every spiritual blessing. That we have an inheritance that can neither spoil nor fade, but which is kept for us in heaven. That those whom Jesus has called he will also glorify.

The gospel expunges the underlying

anxieties that drives much modern self-improvement. In Christ, we are welcome, accepted, secure and significant. Our identity is not found in the decor of our house, the width of our waist, the sophistication of our palate or the length of our title. Our identity is found 'in Christ'.

But is that all we can say on this issue? After all, what we often call the Christian 'life', the Bible usually calls the Christian 'walk'. And this is how Paul prays for the walk of the Christian:

We are asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding, so that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him, bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the knowledge of God. Col 1:9 -10

We are not just sitting still while we await Jesus' return, we walk 'somewhere' - we are to bear fruit and grow.

Of course, even spiritual fruit is seasonal. The psalmist records that the person whose delight is in the Lord's instruction and who meditates on it day and night is

"like a tree planted beside streams of water that bears its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither."

The tree is not constantly in season. It

has its winters. So do Christians - but they do not wither, if they are seeking to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, and when spring comes, so will fruit.

What is this fruit? It is Christian character. As Paul puts it in his letter to the church in Galatia,

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness, self-control." Gal 5:22-23

Christians, then, are passionate about self-improvement. About being so captivated by Jesus, so changed by the gospel, so obedient to his commands that we are constantly being changed.

And if we love each other, then our love will not just be the love that loves us as we are and leaves us there. It will be a love for the good of our sister or brother. It will be love that changes. We long to be the kind of church where every person is loved in this way - as they are, and also for their good. Where someone loves us enough to have a hope and a dream and a vision of who we might be. We don't just believe in self-improvement. We believe in us-improvement. And you-improvement.

How will you love for good, this coming new year?

- My holidays in early January when I will also have a health check.

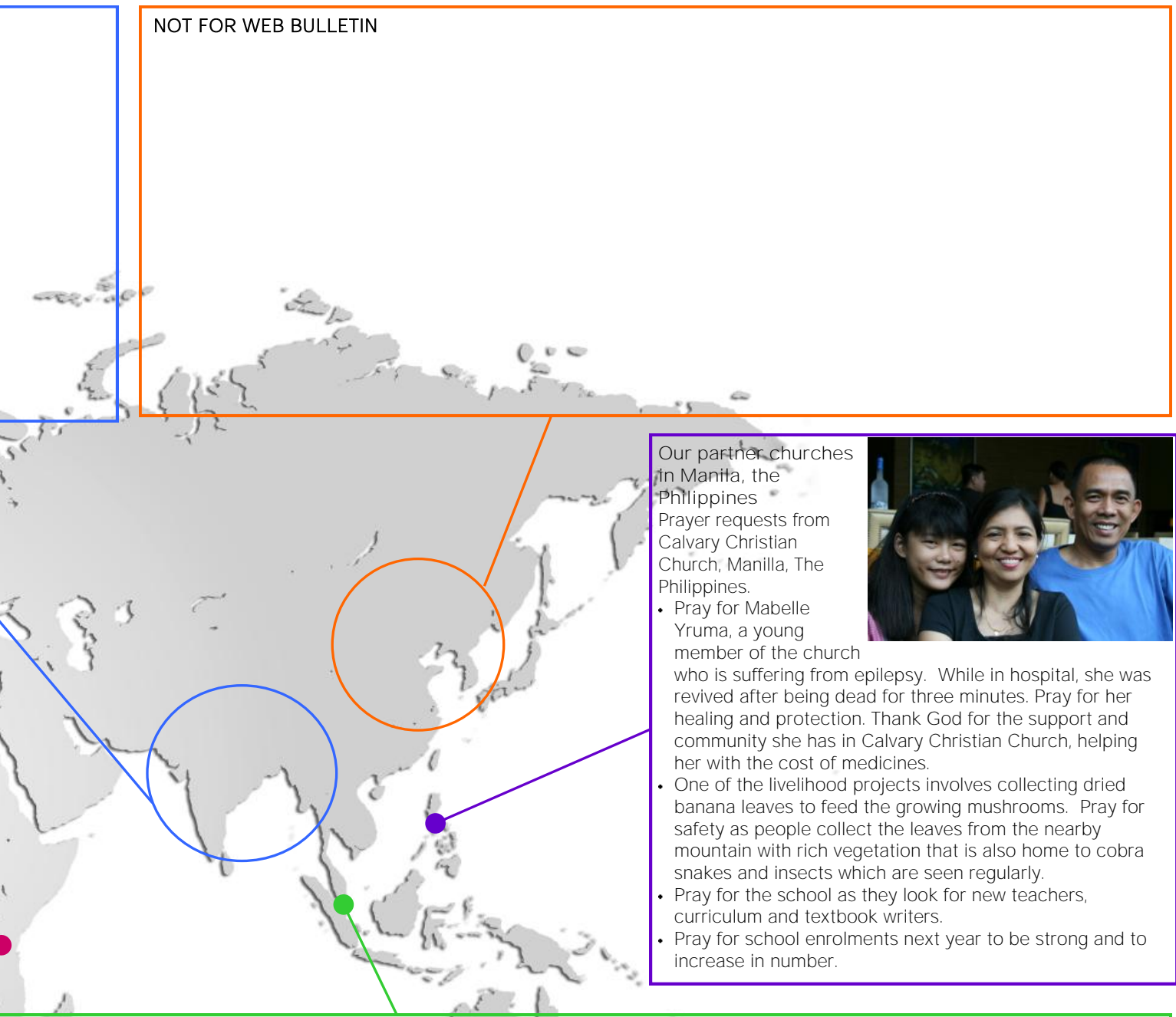

PARISH COUNCIL

Summary of November 2011 meeting

The monthly Parish Council meeting was held on 14 November 2011.

At the meeting:

- **Mike Paget gave an update on the church's** ministry, reporting that by the grace of God, ministry seems to be going well.
- The wardens reported that the new building is progressing well. The date for practical completion is currently early April 2012. The wardens led a discussion regarding options for AV system and the internal fit-out of the building. The wardens and Parish Council have also received positive feedback from the Barneys community about naming parts of the new building after previous Barneys rectors.
- The chair of the Fundraising Committee Peter Stone presented the fundraising report. He reported the exciting news that the total amount fundraised is just under \$4 million. He noted however that there was still \$1.5 million that needed to be raised. He also reported on the status of several grant applications to government and community donors. He urged us to pray for a positive outcome for these applications.
- The church treasurer Grant Parish tabled the October church accounts, noting that they were below budget for the month.

Please pray for the upcoming Parish Council meeting, where the church budget for 2012 will be finalised, that we would have wisdom and discernment. Please also pray for the various fundraising applications and the continued safety of builders constructing the new building.

This is proving to be a challenge for our builder who are doing their best to recover the situation. We are still hoping to be watertight before Christmas which will enable them to have a real go at making good progress on the finishing trades in the new year.

We have had a couple of 'official' visits to site in the past month and now that the bulk of the crane lifts and major overhead works are complete we are planning to start the Saturday morning site tours again. Please register your interest with Kiri in the office.

In terms of progress, a lot of the ceiling linings are being installed as well as some of the interior wall finishes. From the photo below you will see the form of the cross in the wall over our foyer is nearly complete.

Although it has been going for a long time and seems repetitive, please keep safety for all on site in your prayers. And again, there is still much planning to be done around opening events, our interior fit out, and how to best use the spaces for our own community and to engage with the wider community so please do not forget to pray for these.

And finally, site will be shut down for two weeks over Christmas and New Year. As many of us **will be resting and recharging let's hope the site team also benefit from the time for rejuvenation.**

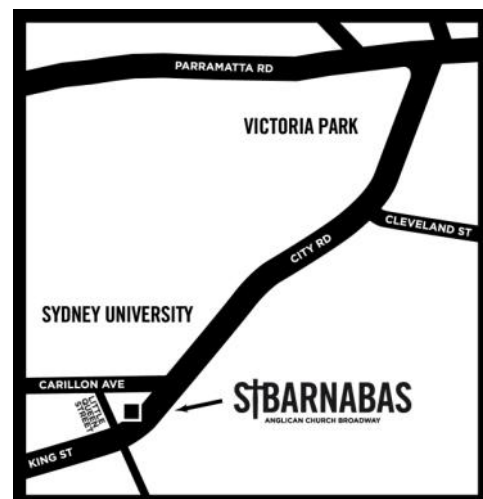

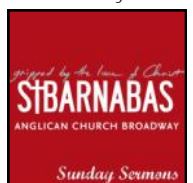
