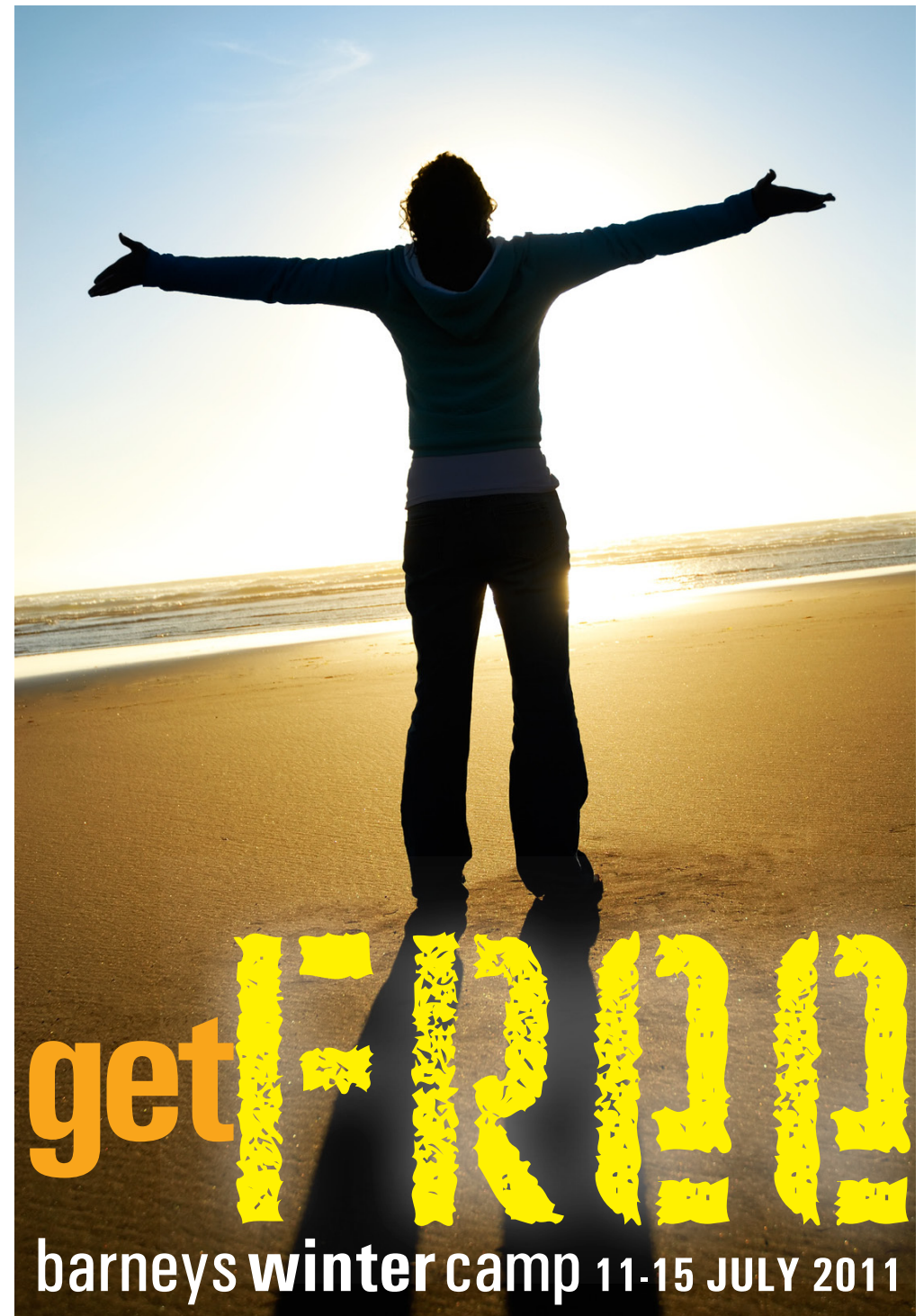
Forms
